"... pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart" 2 Timothy 2:22

December 20th, 2020 - The Comfort of Israel

God's message in the book of Isaiah is "I save!" (It's easy to remember because "Isaiah" and "I save" sound similar). The Israelites constantly looked to the wrong saviors. When the cruel Assyrians threatened the world, Israel trusted their alliances with foreign nations to save them. "'Woe to the rebellious children,' declares the LORD, 'who execute a plan, but not Mine, and make an alliance, but not of My Spirit, in order to add sin to sin. They proceed down to Egypt without consulting Me, to take refuge in the safety of Pharaoh and to seek shelter in the shadow of Egypt!" (Isaiah 30:1-2). Even worse, they trusted in false gods to save them! Isaiah mocks them for cutting down a tree, burning half of it in the fire to keep them warm, then falling down before the other half to worship it. "The rest he makes into a god, his graven image. He falls



down before it and worships; he also prays to it and says, 'Deliver me, for you are my god.'" (Isaiah 44:17). How absurd to look for deliverance from a tree which couldn't even deliver itself from being chopped in half and burned!

God assures them there is no other God! He is the one who will save and comfort His people! "'Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God.'" (Isaiah 40:1). "Indeed, the LORD will comfort Zion; He will comfort all her waste places. And her wilderness He will make like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the sound of melody." (51:3). "As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; and you will be comforted in Jerusalem." (66:13). God promised when their true Savior came, it would be a time of great comfort for Israel.

With that background in mind, fast-forward almost 700 years later to the time Jesus is born. When He was only weeks old, His parents brought Him to the temple where we meet a righteous and devout man named Simeon. Simeon was promised by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death until he saw the Lord's Savior (Luke 2:26). Now watch this — before he saw Jesus, Luke says Simeon was "looking for the Comfort of Israel." (2:25) and when he saw him, he said, "Now Lord, You are releasing You bond-servant to depart in peace, according to Your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation." (2:29-30). How amazing! The comfort and salvation God promised through Isaiah hundreds of years before were all wrapped up in this child!

The greatest source of comfort we have is what Jesus did for us on the cross. No matter how hard life gets, how much pain and sadness we face, and how many things change for the worse, the fact that we've been forgiven by a Savior who loves us will never change. Sadly, like the Israelites, sometimes in our pain we rely on false sources of comfort, like food and entertainment or even sinful things. Sin never satisfies for long, and only brings more pain in the long run. Even good comforting things God gives us to enjoy like warm blankets and hot cocoa can only ever offer us temporary comfort. True, eternal comfort, is only found in Jesus our Lord, the Comfort of Israel.
