# January 3, 2020 - Getting the 3 B's Right

As I consider our goals for reaching the lost this year at PSD, I was struck by a recent podcast where a preacher mentioned the order of three "B's": belonging, belief, and behavior. He argued that churches and individual Christians mess up evangelism by getting those in the wrong order. Our evangelistic efforts lose their power when we aim for behavior first, belief second, and belonging last.

For instance, sometimes we try to convert people by getting them to change their behavior. The only way we'll have anything to do with them is if they stop cussing, stop wearing immodest clothing, and stop being so negative. Then once they get their behavior in order, next we try to get them to bring their beliefs into alignment with the Bible, and only once their beliefs start aligning with ours will we give them a sense of belonging.

That's not how Jesus did it. When Jesus was invited to Matthew's house to eat with sinners and tax collectors, He didn't say, "I'll go, but only if everyone changes their behavior and beliefs first." No, instead He offered them a sense of belonging and



friendship first. When questioned by the Pharisees, Jesus said, "It is not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick." (Matthew 9:12). Can you imagine a doctor who said to his patients, "You're not welcome to come see or talk to me until you fix your illness and the behavior that's causing it"? That would be absurd! Jesus continues, "Go and learn what this means; I desire compassion, and not sacrifice, for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners." (9:13). Jesus knew even sinners with wicked behavior and twisted beliefs need love and compassion. What's more, He understood it's only from a sense of love and belonging that people will be inspired to change their beliefs and behavior. Jesus taught us how to get the three B's right: belonging, belief, then behavior.

It's true non-Christians can't feel a *full* sense of belonging in the church until they put on Christ in baptism, but they should get a taste of it long before! The cross gave us all a taste of belonging long before we were saved. Jesus's death for us sent the message loud and clear: "You belong with me and My Father in Heaven." "By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins." (1 John 4:9-10). That's the message we want to send to the world in 2021: "you belong with Jesus, with your Father in Heaven, and with us." It's only once people know they belong here that their beliefs about themselves and God begin to change. That's when they'll join us on this lifetime journey of behavior change to be more like our Lord. Let's commit in 2021 to getting the three B's right: belonging first, belief second, behavior last.
